

PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT

FOR CONTROL OF RUSSIAN WHEAT APHID IN WINTER CEREALS

PERMIT NUMBER – PER82304

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

CONDITIONS OF USE

Product to be used:

4FARMERS IMIDACLOPRID 600 FLOWABLE SEED DRESSING INSECTICIDE PLUS OTHER REGISTERED SEED TREATMENT PRODUCTS Containing: 600 g/L IMIDACLOPRID as their only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Restraint:

DO NOT ALLOW SEED TREATED WITH THIS PRODUCT TO CONTAMINATE SEED INTENDED FOR HUMAN AND/OR ANIMAL CONSUMPTION.

Crop Type	Pest Insect	Application Rate
WINTER CEREALS Seed treatment only	Russian wheat aphid (Diuraphis noxia)	120 mL product / 100 kg seed

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply one (1) treatment only using appropriate seed mixing/treatment machinery.
- Ensure thorough coverage of seed by using recommended mixture of product and water.
- For winter cereals, apply using a total volume of 400 mL of mixture [product and water] per 100 kg seed. It is essential that the rate of 120 mL product/100 kg seed is applied in the diluted mixture. *Refer to Mixing and Seed Treatment instructions on product label*.

Withholding Periods:

Harvest: Not required when used as directed.

Grazing: DO NOT graze or cut for stock food within 9 WEEKS of sowing.

Jurisdiction:

ALL STATES

Additional Conditions:

This PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.
